


# Stitch 'n Bitch Crochet: The Happy Hooker Corrections & Clarifications

The following corrections are for the first printing. You have a copy of the book from the first printing if the numbers at the very bottom of the page with the copyright info-across from the dedication-read "10 9 8 7 6 5 4 3 2 1"

# PAGE 31

The arrow in figure for step 2 is drawn incorrectly. Please refer to corrected figure, below.



# PAGE 95, STITCH KEY

The symbol for "Back Post Double Crochet" was printed backwards. It should appear as follows:

= back post double crochet (BPdc)

## SWEET PEA SHAWL

The chart for the lace pattern is correct, however, the directions for Row 3 should read as follows: **Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*<u>ch 1</u>, sk next ch-3 space, shell in center ch of next ch-3 loop, <u>ch 1</u>, sk next ch-3 space, sc in next sc; repeat from \* across, turn–19 shells.

## YEEHAW LADY

Under "Special Stitches," directions for **Cluster** should read as follows (note deleted "yo"):

Yo, insert hook in st, yo, draw yarn through st (3 loops on hook),  $\frac{1}{20}$ , sk next st, yo, insert hook in next st, yo, draw yarn through st, yo, draw yarn through 5 loops on hook.

HAT, Rnd 2: Ch 1 (counts as first pointed front sc), sk first sc, ....

**Rnd 7:** ...\*2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next <u>5</u> sc; rep from \* 3 times...

## ANARCHY IRONY HAT

Pattern works as written, but rows are numbered incorrectly (row 10 is missing).

## **BOY BEANIE**

Rnd 6: Ch 3, dc in each of next 8 dc, 2 dc in next dc, \*dc in each of next 9 dc, 2 dc in next dc; rep from \* around ending with dc in each of last 5 dc, sl st in third ch of turning ch to join—55 sts. PAGE 135, ABOUT EMILY Emily's website is: www.hookmeupcrochet.com

## GRANNY'S NO SQUARE

There is an asterisk missing on Rnd 6. It should read, With E: ch 1, <u>\*</u>3 sc in sc (corner made)...

## EXCHANGE BAG

The stitch count after round 3 and round 25 should be 96.

## FAT-BOTTOM BAG

Note: Ch 2 at beginning of each row counts as a st. Skip the first st of each row and work in the turning ch at the end of row.

**Row 1:** Hhdc in 3rd ch from hook, hhdc in each of  $\underline{\text{next 3}}$  <u>ch</u>, 2 hhdc in next ch, hhdc in each of next 5 ch, 2 hhdc in next ch, hhdc in each of last 5 ch, turn - 19 sts.

## BLISSFUL

Some rows are missing in the **Bodice**. Row 4 should read: <u>Rows 4-7: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn–114 (133, 152,</u> 171,190) sc.

Rows 8: Ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn-114 (133, 152, 171, 190) hdc. Fasten off.

This will make the area between the skirt and the cups 3 1/2", not 2 1/2".

Under **Begin Bib**, Row 1 should read: ...hdc in each of next 71 ( $\underline{77}$ , 91, 101, 111) hdc, turn leaving remaining sts unworked - 72 ( $\underline{78}$ , 88, 102, 112) sts.

And the number of sts at the end of Row 2 should be: 68 (<u>78, 88,</u> 98, 108) sts.

## CUPCAKE

Under Sleeve, Rnd 1 should read: Hdc in <u>third</u> ch from hook, hdc in each ch across, turn-9 hdc.

Under Sleeve Edging, Row 2 should read: Row 2: Ch 5 (counts as first dc and ch 2 space), sk next 2 sts, sl st in next dc (center dc of shell), <u>\*</u>ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next st, <u>sk next 2 sts</u>, sl st in next dc (center dc of shell); rep from \* across, turn 18 (18, 20, 20, 22) ch-2 spaces.

## SHORT 'N SWEET

The diagram for the lace pattern is correct, however, the following errors appear in the written directions (note missing ch 2's):

**Under BACK: Row 3:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), dc in first ch-1 space (counts as first V-st), \*ch 2, sc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, skip next ch-2 space, FPdc around the post of each of next 2 dc, BPdc around the post of each of next 2 dc, V-st in next ch-1 space, BPdc around the post of each of next 2 dc, ch 2, skip next ch-2 space, sc in next ch-2 space, <u>ch 2</u>, ...(continue as written)

**Row 4:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), dc in first ch-1 space (counts as first V-st), \*ch 2, sc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, skip next ch-2 space, BPdc around the post of each of next 2 dc, FPdc around the post of each of next 3 dc, V-st in next ch-1 space, FPdc around the post of each of next 3 dc, BPdc around the post of each of next 2 dc, ch 2, skip next ch-2 space, sc in next ch-2 space, <u>ch 2</u>, ...

**Row 5:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), dc in first ch-1 space (counts as first V-st), \*ch 2, skip next 2 ch-2 spaces, FPdc around the post of each of next 2 dc, ch 2, skip next 4 dc, V-st in next ch-1 space, <u>ch 2</u>, ....

**Row 6:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), 4 dc in first ch-1 space (counts as first half shell), \*ch 2, skip next ch-2 space, sc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, V-st in ch-1 space of next V-st, ch 2, sc in next ch-2 space, <u>ch 2</u>, ...

Row 7: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), dc in first ch-1 space (counts as first V-st), \*BPdc around the post of each of next 2 dc, FPdc around the post of each of next 2 dc, ch 2, skip next ch-2 space, sc in next ch-2 space, <u>ch 2</u>, ... Row 8: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), dc in first ch-1 space (counts as first V-st), \*FPdc around the post of each of next 3 dc, BPdc around the post of each of next 2 dc, ch 2, skip next ch-2 space, sc in next ch-2 space, <u>ch 2</u>, ... SLEEVE, Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), dc in first sc (counts as first V-st), \*ch 2, sk next 3 sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, ch 2, <u>sk next 3 sc</u>, ...

## KNOT UGLY SHRUG

Row 12: ... rep from\* to \* <u>18 (18, 19, 20, 21)</u> times

## JOLLY ROGER

Where pattern calls for yarn "A," use MC yarn (black).

#### UNSEAMLY SWEATER

Under All Sizes (page 208) Rnd 3 should read (note missing asterisk): Sl st in first ch-3 loop, ch 1, <u>\*</u>(sc, ch 5, sc, ch 5, sc) in ch-3 loop, ch 5, sk next ch-3 loop, sc in next ch-3 loop, ch 5, sk next ch-3 loop; rep from \* around...

#### FROU FROU

Last line of directions at bottom of page should read: Work in GSP, dec 1 ch-1 space at each end of every seventh row 5 times-28 (32, 36, 40, 44) ch-1 spaces.

#### FLUFFY BUNNY SLIPPERS

**Gauge** With yarns A & B held together: <u>14</u> sts and <u>16</u> rows sc = 4"

**BOTTOM SOLE:** Rnd 3: <u>Ch 3</u>, 2 dc in next dc, \*dc in each of next 19 dc, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc) 3 times, dc in each of next 17 dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, <u>dc in last dc</u>, sl st to 3rd ch of turning ch to join - 58 sts.

**Rnd 4:** <u>Ch 3</u>, dc in <u>next</u> dc, 2 dc in next dc, \*dc in each of next 20 dc, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc) 3 times, dc in each of next 17 dc, 2 dc in next dc, <u>dc in next 3 dc</u>, 2 dc in next dc, dc in last 2 dc, sl st to 3rd ch of turning ch to join - 64 sts. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

#### VIOLET BEAUREGARD

Under Skirt, Rnd 2 (eyelet round) area between the

asterisks should read: ...\*dc in each of next 3 dc, ch<u>2</u>, sk next 2 dc; rep from \*...

Under Scalloped Border, Rnd 1, area between asterisks should read: ...\*dc in next st, ch 2, <u>sk next 2 sts</u>, (3dc, ch 2, 3dc) in next st, ch 2, sk next 2 sts; rep from \*...

#### LADYLIKE LACE GLOVES

Under **Special Stitches**, "2-dc cluster across <del>next</del> 4 sts" should read: <u>Yo</u>, insert hook into same st as last dc worked, yo, draw yarn through st, yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook, sk next 2 sc, <u>yo</u>, insert hook in next st, yo, draw yarn through st, yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook, yo, draw yarn through 3 loops on hook.

"2-dc cluster across next 3 sts" should read: <u>Yo</u>, insert hook into same st as last dc worked, yo, draw yarn through st, yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook, sk next sc, <u>yo</u>, insert hook in next st, yo, draw yarn through st, yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook, yo, draw yarn through 3 loops on hook.

BACK, Row 4 should read: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), <u>sk</u> <u>first 2 sc</u>, dc in next sc (counts as first cluster), \*ch 2, <del>sk</del> <del>next 2 sts</del>, work 2-dc cluster across <del>next</del> 4 sts (see special stitches); rep from \* across to last 2 sts, ch 2, work 2-dc cluster over <del>next</del> 3 sts (see special stitches) <del>working firstdc in next sc, sk next sc, work second dc in next sc (2-dc cluster made), turn–17 clusters.</del>

Work the following row between rows 19 & 20: Ch1, sc in back loop of each stitch across, turn-50 sc.

**PALM**: The total st count at the end of rows 38 & 39 is 50 Row 40: Ch 1, sc in back loop of each of the first 14 sc, hdc in each of the next <u>36</u> sc (delete remainder of row directions) – 50 sts.

Row 44 Ch1, hdc in back loop of each of first <u>29</u> sts, <u>2 hdc</u> in next hdc, ...(continue as written).

Rows 46-49: replace with: Rep rows 42-45

Row 52: Ch1, hdc in back loop of each of the first  $\underline{18}$  hdc,  $\underline{2 \text{ hdc in next hdc}}$ , ...(continue as written).

**THUMB, Row 28** should read: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), <u>sk</u> first 2 sc, dc in next sc (counts as first cluster), \*ch 2, <del>sk 2 sts</del>, work 2-dc cluster across <del>next</del> 4 sts; rep from \* across to last sc, dc in last sc, turn -15 clusters.

## BEDFELLOWS

For the larger size hook, try using an L/11 (8mm). For the ARMS and LEGS for both bunny and bear, work only 16 rnds (not 24).

#### LIL MONKEY

Special Stitches

**Bobble:** (Yo, insert hook in next space, yo, draw yarn through space, yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook) 3 times in same space, yo, draw yarn through <u>4 loops</u> on hook. Also, listed in **Materials**, the correct size hook to use on the afghan pattern is 9.00 mm, which can be either an M/13 or an N/13, depending on the brand of hook.

#### SEIJA SET

Under Blanket, Row 1 should read: Dc in fourth ch from hook, dc in each <u>ch</u> across, turn-74 sts.
